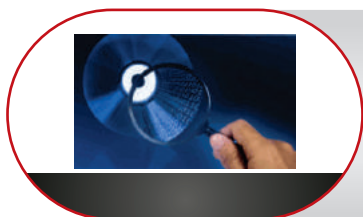
Career Counseling Committee

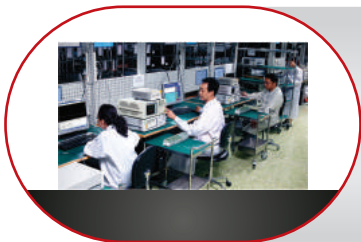
Personality Enrichment Committee
